## **NJ ISSUES ORDER REVISING PIP ATTENDING PROVIDER TREATMENT PLAN FORM**

### **BACKGROUND**

The New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance requires providers to use the Attending Provider Treatment Plan form to submit treatment and testing requests to insurers under the Personal Injury Protection (PIP) coverage of automobile insurance.

NJDOBI has issued Order A16-101 that requires providers to use a revised Attending Provider Treatment Plan.

### **COMPANY ACTION**

On or before April 15, 2016, all providers must use the revised Attending Provider Treatment Plan form to submit Decision Point Review and Precertification Requests. No other forms for this purpose are permitted. Insurer and PIP vendors are encouraged to program the form on their websites so that it can be downloaded, completed and printed by the provider.
