UPCOMING CHANGES**

**BACKGROUND**

MSO® updates its existing programs and designs new products that can periodically have an impact on the Statistical Plan. MSO is making a few changes to its Plan for updates, clarifications, and corrections in 2016.

**ACTION/CHANGES**

The following items will be included in the next Statistical Plan revision:

- Excess and Umbrella Liability changes previously announced in Bulletin 2015-02 dated 12/17/15
- Territory codes for all states
- Clarifications and corrections to 2014 filing, including Accident Prevention code applies only in the state of NY only and Territory Type Indicator applies to certain states
- Cause of Loss codes for Drones and Aircrafts
- Expanded CDL Medical Payment codes
- Type of Policy code for new Brewery Businessowners (BOP) Specialty Program
- BOP class code for Dry Cleaners including Work risk
- Builder's Risk Classification code for Inland Marine
