STATISTICAL DATA CALL ANNOUNCEMENT
STATE REGULATOR TERRORISM RISK INSURANCE ACT (TRIA)**

ANNOUNCEMENT

The National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) issued a mandatory data call for collection of terrorism risk insurance information to all property & casualty insurers writing certain commercial lines of insurance. The New York Department of Financial Services (DFS) will be responsible for the data collection. All states and the District of Columbia have agreed to the call.

All domestic insurers writing commercial fire and allied, commercial multi-peril, ocean marine, inland marine, other liability, products liability, and boiler & machinery lines are required to respond by September 30, 2016.

Participating state insurance regulators will be sending notices and instructions for the terrorism risk data call.
