STATISTICAL DATA CALL REVISED DUE DATE  
STATE REGULATOR TERRORISM RISK INSURANCE ACT (TRIA)**

**ANNOUNCEMENT**

The National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) on behalf of the state insurance regulators had issued a mandatory data call for collection of terrorism risk insurance information to all property & casualty insurers writing certain commercial lines of insurance.

The due date for this call has been extended and is now **November 1, 2016**.

Based on interpretation of the various documents available, it appears **all** companies must make some type of response either by providing the data via the New York Department of Financial Services website or by requesting an exemption if not writing lines of business impacted by the mandated TRIA coverage via [triahelp@naic.org](mailto:triahelp@naic.org). Include all pertinent details in the response.
