



PENNSYLVANIA AUTO FRAUD WARNING NOTICE

BACKGROUND Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes 75 Pa C.S.A. § 1822 requires all motor

vehicle insurance applications, renewals and claims forms to contain the

following warning notice wording:

Any person who knowingly and with intent to injure or defraud any insurer files

an application or claim containing any false, incomplete or misleading

information shall, upon conviction, be subject to imprisonment for up to seven

years and payment of a fine of up to \$15,000.

MSO ACTION MSO has created Auto Fraud Warning Notice – PA Notice 001 01 17,

containing this wording that can be added to a policy at renewal. A notice still

must be included on the application and on claims forms.
