



NEW YORK DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL SERVICES CYBER SECURITY REGULATION

BACKGROUND	The New York State Department of Financial Services (NYDFS) enacted Regulation 23 NYCRR 500, Cybersecurity Requirements for Financial Services Companies. The regulation became effective March 1, 2017.
COMPANY ACTION	All New York financial companies "operating under or required to operate under a license, registration, charter, certificate, permit, accreditation or similar authorization under the Banking Law, the Insurance Law or the Financial Services Law" must respond to NYDFS in some capacity.
