SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE CYBER SECURITY REGULATION

BACKGROUND

The South Carolina Department of Insurance enacted the South Carolina Insurance Data Security Act modeled after the NAIC Insurance Data Security Model Law. The regulation becomes effective on January 1, 2019.

COMPANY ACTION

All South Carolina licensees (with few exceptions) defined as “any person licensed, authorized to operate, or registered to be licensed, authorized, or registered pursuant to the insurance laws of this State” must respond to the South Carolina Insurance Data Security Act. Beginning January 1, 2019, licensees must comply with the reporting requirements among other requirements. Other key dates start as early as July 1, 2019.
