

TERRORISM RISK INSURANCE ACT (TRIA) EXTENDED THROUGH 2027 NEW VIRGINIA TERRORISM ENDORSEMENTS AVAILABLE

BACKGROUND In December, the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act (TRIA) was

reauthorized and extended for seven years with no structural changes.

TRIA had been set to expire December 31, 2020.

Policies issued between January 2, 2020 and December 31, 2020 would have fallen partly under the provisions of TRIA. After December 31, 2020, the terrorism endorsements on these policies would not apply as

they were contingent on TRIA being in place.

MSO® ACTION Last fall, MSO filed and received approval for Post-TRIA endorsements

to replace the 01 05 editions in the event that Congress did not act before the end of 2019. However, with the timely reauthorization of TRIA, MSO, Inc. refiled the 01 15 editions with new edition dates as the Virginia Department of Insurance would not permit more than one version of an endorsement with the same form number. These endorsements are identical

to the 01 15 editions except for a 01 20 edition date.
