DEFINITION OF REPLACEMENT VEHICLE REVISED IN MARYLAND COMMERCIAL AUTO ENDORSEMENTS

BACKGROUND	<p>In order to more closely track with the provisions in MD. CODE ANN., TRANSP. § 17-104, MSO®, Inc. has revised the definition of "replacement vehicle" in MCA 800, MCA 801 and MCA 840. The new definition is as follows:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><i>Replacement vehicle</i> means a vehicle that is loaned by or rented from an <i>auto</i> repair facility or dealer, or that an individual rents temporarily, to use while a vehicle owned by the borrower, lessee or rentee is not in use because of its breakdown, repair, servicing or damage.</p>
MSO ACTION	<p>MSO, Inc. has filed and received approval for the revised Maryland Commercial Auto endorsements.</p>
EFFECTIVE DATE	<p>September 1, 2021</p>
COMPANY ACTION	<p>Companies writing Commercial Auto in Maryland are encouraged to adopt the revised endorsements in order to track with MD. CODE ANN., TRANSP. § 17-104.</p>
